The intent of the criminal trespass program is to assist property owners in addressing crime occurring on their property.

The new program will also provide uniform agreements and signage for property owners that will help ensure that arrests under this program lead to successful prosecution.

Any person who is found to be in violation of the posted conditions will be subject to receipt of a *Trespass Warning*. Once a person has received this warning- they will be subject to immediate arrest if they are found again at that address in violation of the conditions of entry.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

Step one: Fill out an agreement form

- Businesses should contact their police precincts to obtain a trespass authorization form
- This can be done either in person at the precinct, or via email

Step two: Order a sign or get one printed

- Businesses that want to participate in the program must have the new "Conditions of Entry" sign

Step three: Post your sign in a prominent location
